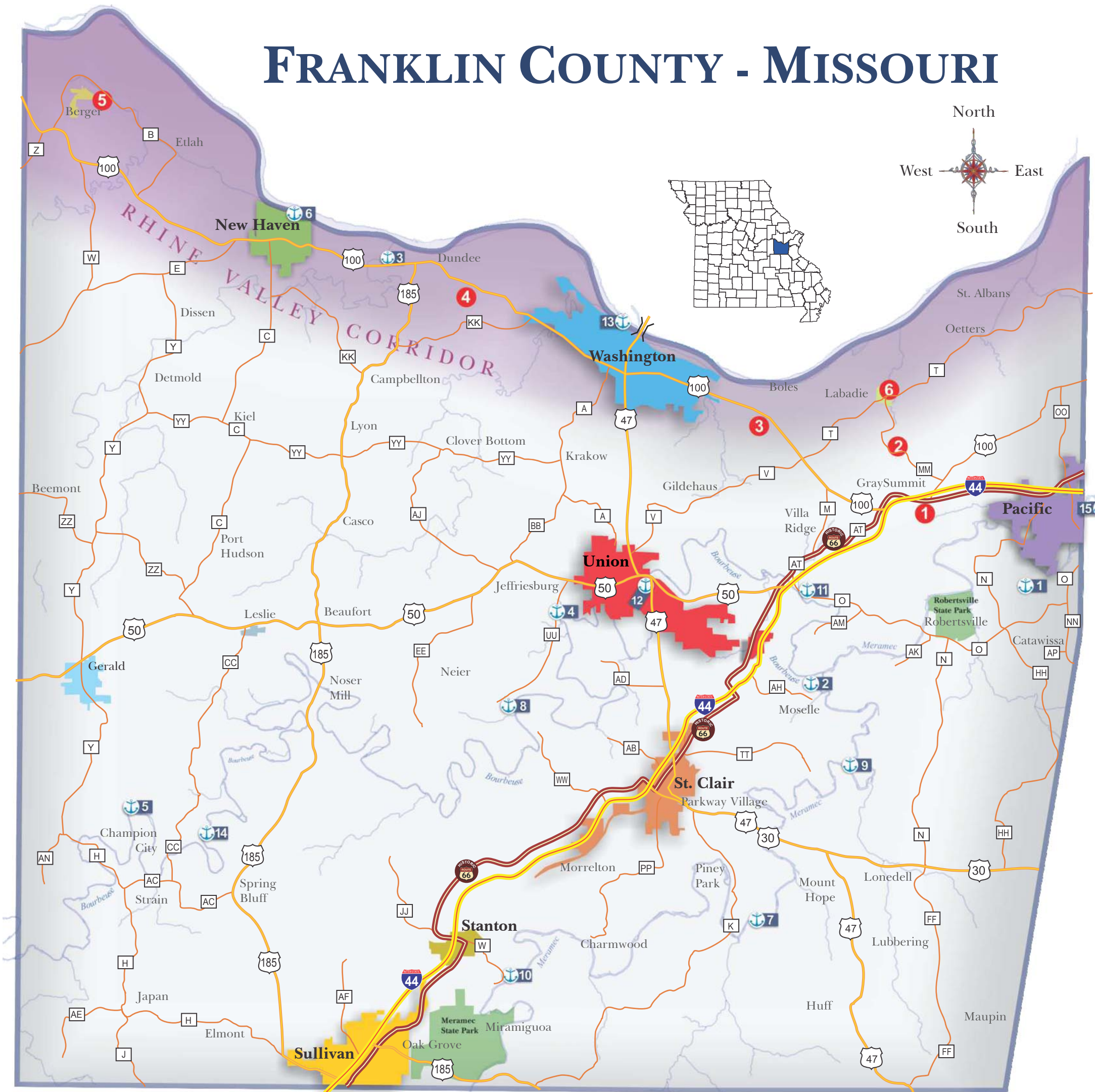

- 1 **Catawissa Conservation Area** (Meramec River) Hwy. N to Frisco Dr. - Not usable during low water.
